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What is the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan Formulary?

A formulary is a list of drugs, selected by the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan in consultation with a team of health care providers, which represent the prescription therapies believed to be a necessary part of a quality treatment program. The Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan will generally cover the drugs listed in our formulary as long as the drug is medically necessary, the prescription is filled at a Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan network pharmacy, and other plan rules are followed. For more information on how to fill your prescriptions, please review your group plan *Evidence of Coverage*.

Can the Formulary change?

Yes, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan may add or remove drugs from our formulary during the year. The enclosed formulary is current as of January 1, 2006. To get updated information about the drugs covered by Blue Shield, please visit our Web site at mylifepath.com or call Customer Service at **(888) 239-6469**, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. (excluding holidays), TTY/TDD users should call **(888) 239-6482**.

If we remove drugs from our formulary, or add prior authorization, quantity limits and/or step therapy restrictions on a drug (or move a drug to a higher cost-sharing tier), we must notify members who take the drug that it will be removed at least 60 days before the date that the change becomes effective, or at the time the member requests a refill of the drug, at which time the member will receive a 60-day supply of the drug. If the Food and Drug Administration deems a drug on our formulary to be unsafe or the drug's manufacturer removes the drug from the market, we will immediately remove the drug from our formulary and provide notice to members who take the drug.

How do I use the Formulary?

There are two ways to find your drug within the formulary:

Medical Condition

The formulary begins on page 4. The drugs in this formulary are grouped into categories depending on the type of medical conditions that they are used to treat. For example, drugs used to treat a heart condition are listed under the category, "Cardiovascular Agents." If you know what your drug is used for, look for the category name in the list that begins on page 5. Then look under the category name for that drug.

Alphabetical Listing

If you are not sure what category to look under, you should look for your drug in the Index that begins on page 36. The Index provides an alphabetical list of all of the drugs included in this document. Both brand-name drugs and generic drugs are listed in the Index. Look in the Index and find your drug. Next to your drug, you will see the page number where you can find coverage information. Turn to the page listed in the Index and find the name of your drug in the first column of the list.

Are there any other restrictions on coverage?

Some covered drugs may have additional requirements or limits on coverage. These requirements and limits may include:

- **Prior Authorization:** the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan requires you to get prior authorization for certain drugs. (You may need prior authorization for drugs that are on the formulary or drugs that are not on the formulary **and** were approved for coverage through our exceptions process.) This means that you will need to get approval from the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan before you fill your prescriptions. If you don't get approval, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan may not cover the drug.
- **Quantity Limits:** For certain drugs, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan limits the amount of the drug that the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan will cover. For example, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan provides nine tablets per month, per prescription, for *sumatriptan* (IMITREX). This may be in addition to a standard 30- or 90-day supply.
- **Step Therapy:** In some cases, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan requires you

to first try certain drugs to treat your medical condition before we will cover another drug for that condition. For example, if Drug A and Drug B both treat your medical condition, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan may not cover Drug B unless you try Drug A first. If Drug A does not work for you, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan will then cover Drug B.

You can find out if your drug has any additional requirements or limits by looking in the formulary that begins on page 4.

You can ask the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan to make an exception to these restrictions or limits. See the section, "How do I request an exception to the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan Formulary?," on this page for information about how to request an exception.

What if my drug is not on the Formulary?

If your drug is not included in this formulary, you should first contact Customer Service and ask if your drug is covered. **Your benefit may include coverage for non-formulary drugs, at a higher non-formulary copayment.** If you learn that the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan does not cover your drug, you have two options:

- You can ask Customer Service for a list of similar drugs that are covered by the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan. When you receive the list, show it to your doctor and ask him or her to prescribe a similar drug that is covered by the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan.
- You can ask the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan to make an exception and cover your drug. See below for information about how to request an exception.

How do I request an exception to the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan Formulary?

You can ask the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan to make an exception to our coverage rules. There are several types of exceptions that you can ask us to make.

- You can ask us to cover your drug even if it is not on our formulary.
- You can ask us to waive coverage restrictions or limits on your drug. For example, for certain drugs, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan limits the amount of the drug that we will cover. If your drug has a quantity limit, you can ask us to waive the limit and cover more.

Generally, the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan will only approve your request for an exception if the alternative drugs included on the plan's formulary,

the low-tiered drug or additional utilization restrictions would not be as effective in treating your condition and/or would cause you to have adverse medical effects.

You should contact us to ask us for an initial coverage decision for a formulary, tiering or utilization restriction exception. When you are requesting a formulary, tiering or utilization restriction exception, you should submit a statement from your physician supporting your request. Generally, we must make our decision within 72 hours of your request.

What are generic drugs?

The Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan covers both brand-name drugs and generic drugs. A generic drug has the same active ingredient formula as the brand-name drug. Generic drugs usually cost less than brand-name drugs and are approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Generic drugs are listed in lower-case italics (e.g., *lisinopril*) within the formulary. Brand-name drugs are capitalized in the formulary (e.g., ZESTRIL).

The formulary provides coverage information about some of the drugs covered by the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan. If you have trouble finding your drug in the list, turn to the index that begins on page 36.

The first column of the formulary lists the drug name. Brand-name drugs are capitalized (e.g. ZESTRIL) and generic drugs are listed in lower-case italics (e.g., *lisinopril*).

The information in the Requirements/Limits Codes column tells you if the Blue Shield of California Medicare Rx Plan has any special requirements for coverage of your drug.
